Irish Dredging is a subsidiary of Royal Boskalis Westminster nv, one of the world's largest dredging groups and with the support of other group subsidiaries Irish Dredging has the capability and resources to undertake the complete spectrum of dredging related tasks including coastal, inland waterway and seabed protection and have undertaken maintenance and capital dredging works throughout Ireland, in recent years operating in locations such as Drogheda, Arklow, Foynes, Rosslare and Belfast.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The works are for the maintenance dredging of the River Liffey from the East Link Bridge to the outermost section of the Fairway, approximately 1.5 nautical miles seaward of the breakwaters, along with the specified berth pockets within the port area.

Bi-annual campaigns in the order of 4 weeks per campaign are undertaken with the dredge volumes expected to be in the order of 400,000m³. The dredge materials are generally silt inside the port and sand in the approach channel.


The term contract includes an element of contaminated material up river which is to be dredged first and capped at the disposal area in accordance with the Environmental Protection Agency disposal at sea permit.
